### ***PURPOSE***

Frequently, personnel will be required to perform duties for ECFR that require the driving of motorized apparatus or vehicles. To assure that the individual can operate the vehicle safely and legally, the county requires that personnel have an appropriate driver's license.

### ***OBJECTIVE***

To ensure ECFR personnel meet the requirements for a valid driver's license.

### ***SCOPE***

All Personnel

### **DRIVERS LICENSE**

All career personnel must maintain a valid State of Florida Class D license, with an "E" endorsement. This allows for the operation of emergency apparatus throughout their career with the department. Volunteer personnel only need a Class D license with "E" endorsement if they operate department apparatus or vehicles.

Personnel must immediately notify their assigned Battalion Chief or District Chief any time their driver's license is suspended or revoked for any reason.

No ECFR personnel shall drive any department vehicle or any other vehicle covered by county insurance policies, either in emergency or non-emergency mode, without possessing a valid driver's license.

Upon issuance or renewal of their Florida Driver's License, a legible photocopy shall be forwarded to the Training/Safety Division.

### **DRIVING RECORD REVIEW**

ECFR may periodically review the driving records of its personnel to determine the eligibility of drivers to initially operate, or continue to operate department vehicles and apparatus.
